

EMMANUEL 2016



Emmanuel is about getting second level students to sing and enjoy liturgical music. The highlight of the year is participating in the Helix Concerts after a fun filled day of workshops and rehearsals with students from other schools.

Last year more than 2000 students took part in the project from 63 schools in the Archdiocese of Dublin over three days – 700 per day. This is our 10th year and the interest seems to be on the increase. On our first concert we had 340 students in the National Concert Hall for one night.

Would you like your school to be part of this exciting programme that will offer you music in a variety of styles and traditions to enhance your school liturgies throughout the year?

The Helix Days will be 1, 2 and 3 March 2016. The day begins at 11.00 a.m. with workshops and rehearsals. Students bring their own lunch and can eat in the DCU canteen. We provide a hot meal around 6.00 p.m. and the concert starts at 7.30 p.m.



We look for a contribution of €10 per student to help with the costs. Each student will receive a music book and the evening meal. 3 CDs per 10 students will also be supplied. Teachers will receive their own books and CDs at the in-service training sessions as follows:
