The arrangement of this bread reflects the way in which 'The Bread of Presence' or 'Showbread' was presented on a table in the temple in Old Testament times as an offering to God. Although we no longer have to follow such rituals, as our relationship with God is now through Jesus, it helps us remember that we are called to honour, obey and give thanks to our heavenly Father on a daily basis.

EAT

If you would like to, tear off a piece of bread and eat it.

PRAY

Give thanks to God in your own words or pray:

My Father in heaven, thank you for who You are, the Creator of all things. I acknowledge that You are all powerful and I pray that I may play my part in seeing Your rule and reign come on earth. AMEN.

Here we ask God for everything we need to live fully in His plan for our lives on a daily basis. We ask forgiveness for anything we have done which is outside of His plan.

The Hot Cross Buns represent us coming to the foot of the cross where Jesus made the ultimate sacrifice so that we had a way back to God. It is a place where we should return on a daily basis.

EAT

If you would like to, tear off a piece of bread and eat it.

PRAY

Ask God to meet your daily needs in your own words or pray:

Father God, please provide me with everything I need to fully live out the life that You have planned for me. Forgive for the things that I have done which are outside of your good plan for me.

Thank you for Jesus and all that He has done for me. AMEN

EAT

PRAY

Ask God to help you share His love through Jesus in your own words or pray:

Father, help me to love and forgive others. Help me to share the love of Jesus with others through everything I do. Make me a blessing to everyone I meet so that all I do gives glory to you. AMEN
