
### **The First Passover (Ex 12:21-27)**

Moses called for all the leaders of Israel and said to them, 'Each of you is to choose a lamb

or a young goat and kill it, so that your families can celebrate Passover.

Take a sprig of hyssop, dip it in the bowl containing the animal's blood, and wipe the blood on the doorposts and the beam above the door of your house. Not one of you is to leave the house until morning.



When the Lord goes through Egypt to kill the Egyptians, he will see the blood on the beams and on the doorposts and will not let the Angel of Death enter your houses and kill you. You and your children must obey these rules forever. When you enter the land that the Lord has promised to give you, you must perform this ritual.

When your children ask you, "What does this ritual mean?", you will answer, "It is the sacrifice of Passover to honour the Lord, because he passed over the houses of the Israelites in Egypt. He killed the Egyptians, but spared us." '

### **The Last Supper (Lk 22:13-20)**

The apostles Peter and John went off and found everything just as Jesus had told them, and they prepared the Passover meal. When the hour came, Jesus took his place at the table with the apostles. He said to them, 'I have wanted so much to eat this Passover meal with you before I suffer! ...' Then Jesus took a cup, gave thanks to God, and said, 'Take this and share it among yourselves ...' Then Jesus took a piece of bread, gave thanks to God, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in memory of me.' In the same way, he gave them the cup after the supper, saying, 'This cup is God's new covenant sealed with my blood, which is poured out for you.'
