His parents did not know this; they thought he was with the group, so they travelled a whole day and then started looking for him among their relatives and friends. They did not find him, so they went back to Jerusalem looking for him. On the third day, Mary and Joseph found Jesus in the temple sitting with the teachers, listening to them and asking questions. All who heard him were amazed at his answers. His parents were astonished when they saw him, and his mother said to him, 'Son, why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been terribly worried trying to find you? But Jesus answered them, 'Why did you have to look for me? Didn't you know that I had to be in my Father's house?' But they did not understand his answer. Jesus went back to Nazareth with Mary and Joseph. He respected them, and he drew in mind and body. He also grew in love of God and of others.
