



THE O-ANTIPHONS

These O-Antiphons are used in the Daily Lectionary from the 17-24 December, as the verse for the Gospel Acclamation.

At Mass the Minister of the Word reads the verse after the Assembly proclaims *Alleluia*. After the verse, the Assembly again proclaims Alleluia.




'O Wisdom of the Most High, teach us the way of truth.'
