- It celebrates a Saint important to the whole Church or to the local community


We bless ourselves as we make the Sign of the Cross:

- These two candles we name as the waiting in hope candle and the peace candle

We stand to acclaim the Gospel


Teacher/Priest: A reading from the Gospel according to St Luke (Lk 1:26-38)

Response: Glory to you, O Lord.

(make the threefold sign of the cross i.e. With your **thumb** make the sign of the cross on your **forehead**, to think about God's word, make the cross on your **lips** to speak the word of God; make the sign of the cross on your **heart** to show you love the Word of God).

At the end of the Gospel the priest/ teacher/reader will say. The Gospel of the Lord.

Response: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.



The message of the Gospel: The Annunciation

- God sent the Angel Gabriel to Mary to ask her to be the Mother of God.
- At first, Mary was disturbed and frightened.
- The Angel said "Do not be afraid."
- Mary trusted in God and said she would do what God asked. She said "I am the handmaid of the Lord."
- Then the Angel left her.



At the Visitation Mary said a lovely prayer of thanks. It is called *Magnificat* (Grow in Love 6 4th

Class upwards)

Mary went to visit Elizabeth when she heard Elizabeth was pregnant.

Both Mary and Elizabeth were excited because they were both expecting babies.

You can read the story of the Visitation in St Luke's Gospel (Lk 1:39-56). You will read the Magnificat. You can sing it also. (*Grow in Love* Fourth Class/P6).

The Magnificat is Mary's song of thanksgiving to God for choosing her as Mother of his Son..

St Joseph

Joseph was very worried about all this but the angel came and told him not to worry.

When we pray the rosary we honour Mary

- Each decade of the rosary tells a story about the life of Jesus and/or Mary
- You can read the stories of the Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious Mysteries in the Bible. You will also read there the stories of the Mysteries of Light.
- To say a decade of the Rosary you only need to say one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, and one Glory be to the Father.



Let us love Mary by praying to her. Say these prayers. The response is: Lord, graciously hear us.

- God chose Mary as the Mother of his Son. God wants all generations to call Mary blessed. Let us do that. Lord hear us...
- God did great things for Mary.
 Let us say thanks. Lord hear us...
- We ask God through the prayers of Mary to heal the sick, forgive our sins, bring peace to the world, bless all families. Lord hear us....






