- While the resource has a focus on Mary, we remember Mary always leads us to her Son Jesus.



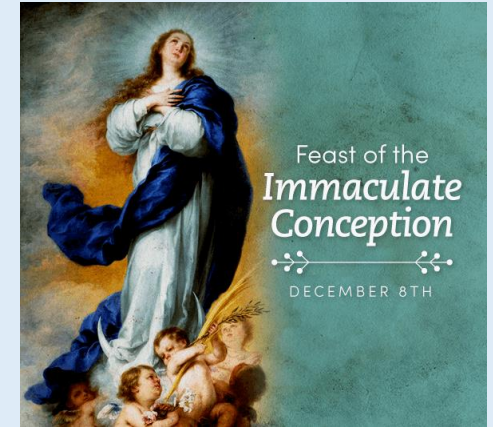
