


We Remember those who died in Covid and their loved ones..

- In our prayer, we thank God the gift of love and life and we ask God to console those who are sad and lonely.







- Together with the Bishops of Ireland we will pray on next Sunday 14 November for this intention



READER 1:



READER:



All: Lord graciously hear us.


Reader 6: We pray for peace in our world, that we may all live as one family. Lord hear us.
